

STATE SCHOLARSHIPS

What is it?

They help you **support your child's education**, with financial aid and others.

For whom?

They are intended for low-income **families**. You may be entitled to them, especially if you do not pay income tax.

They depend on your household **income** and the **number** of dependent children, which appear on the income tax return.

DON'T FORGET TO FILE YOUR INCOME TAX RETURN!

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO CHECK ELIGIBILITY AND ASSESS YOUR RIGHTS!

Why?

Having a scholarship means:

- Money to cover your child's school expenses;
- Cheaper cafeteria and boarding;
- A bonus for choosing a general education high school in 10th grade;
- **Priority** on Parcoursup (in the order of candidates called);
- Other student assistance from CROUS (meals, housing...).

When?

Two steps, in May and September:

• Declare your income:

from 11 April to 23 May 2024 (Ain), from 11 April to 30 May 2024 (Loire), from 11 April to 6 June 2024 (Rhône);

• Apply for a scholarship: from 1st September to 17 October 2024.

How?

- By finding through the <u>@france-services</u> app the welcome point nearest to your home.
